We commit to come alongside displaced pregnant teenagers, show grace and compassion to their circumstances, and encourage them to develop positive life choices.



Our Goal

We strive to prepare the young women we serve for independent living, by offering the following services:

- Parenting training and/or adoption assistance
- Continued education and academic support
- Job skills training
- Household management
- Spiritual guidance
- Counseling
- Quality healthcare
- Recovery program

Our Method

While under the guidance of live-in house parents, residents will receive a model of a loving Christian home as they live together as a family learning to care for both their home and one another.

Brighter Futures will promote self-empowerment by helping our residents discover and develop their unique gifts and talents thereby breaking the cycle of generational teen pregnancy, poverty, and low self-worth.

Our Concern

Brighter Futures is a safe haven for unwed pregnant teens whose alternatives are homelessness, abusive relationships, and/or family conflict. A 2005 study done at the University of Chicago indicated two-thirds of homeless youth ages 12-21 are female. Pregnancy was the number one reason cited for homeless girls running away from

home. Without the support and guidance of healthy adults, a safe place to live, and proper healthcare, these young women and their unborn children are at risk. The number one cause of infant death (birth to 3 years) in the

United States is trauma inflicted by the boyfriend of the birth mother. At Brighter Futures, our vision is to protect life and provide a better quality of life for both the mother and the infant through making resources, parental and professional guidance, and opportunity available to these young women.

Our Hope

By providing these young women with the means to finish their education, make healthier choices, restore their self-esteem, and prepare for parenting or the alternative of adoption, we hope to show the unconditional love and acceptance of Christ for all life and preserve the lives, hopes and dreams of future generations.
